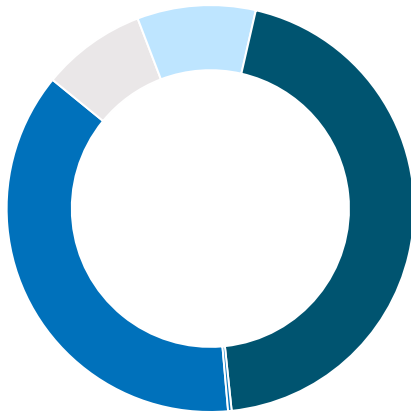

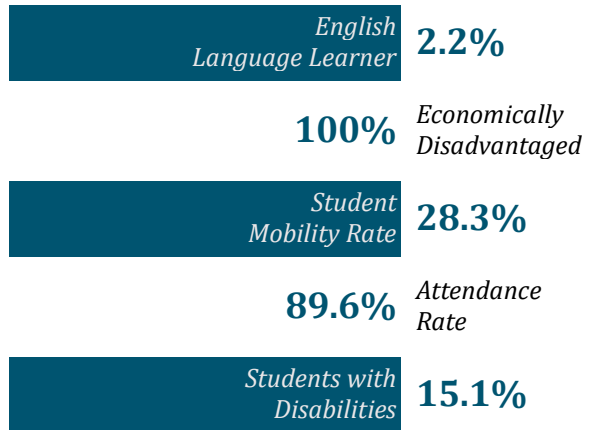

Progress towards Goals

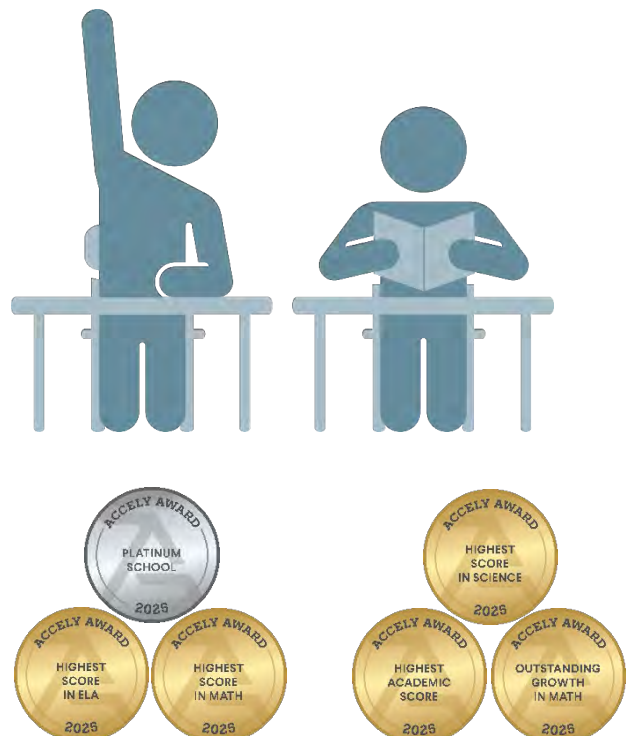
Using the state assessment, the percentage of students proficient in **ELA** increased from **64.7%** in 2023-24 to **76.5%** in 2024-25. STEAM of Warren saw an almost **18** percentage point increase in **Mathematics** from 2024 to 2025. The **Early Literacy Percentage** has increased by over **20** percentage points since the 2022-23 academic year. **Chronic Absenteeism** decreased from **51%** to **36%** from 2024 to 2025.

Our Academic Goals

- By FY2027, the **chronic absenteeism** percentage will decrease by **20%**.
- By FY 2027, using the **iReady Diagnostic**, student proficiency in Math will increase **30%**.
By FY2027, the overall percentage of students improving on **the Early Literacy Measure** will increase by **30%**.

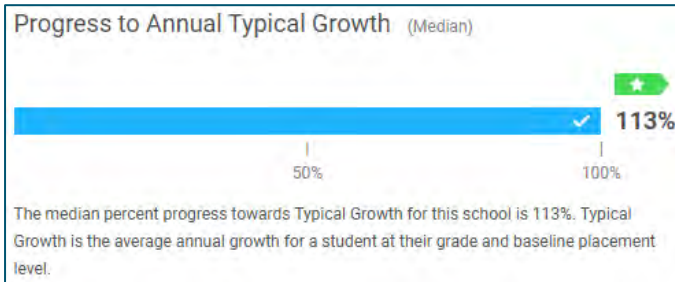

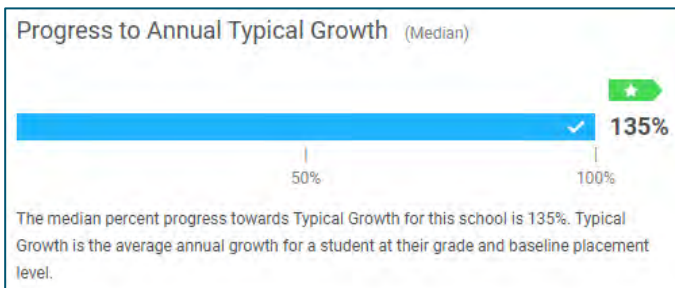

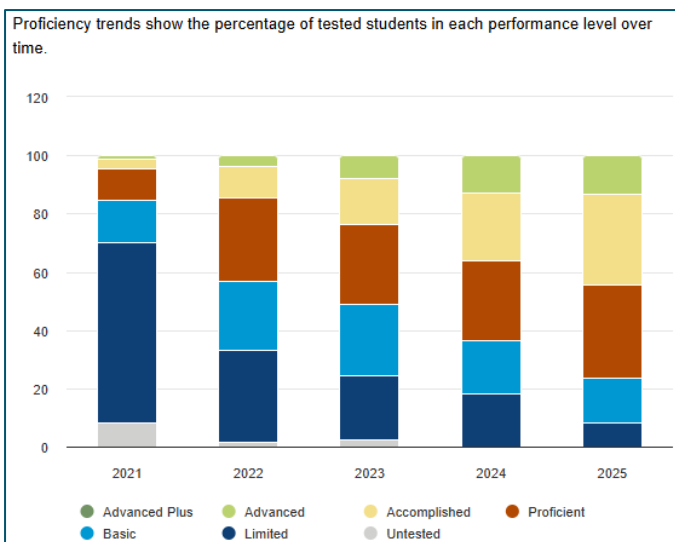
iReady Data Reading
